How Does the Fox Trot Work?

Students Collect Pledge Donations

Collecting pledges is easier than you think - most people are happy to help. The key is to ask! On Monday, October 1st, Pledge Sheets will be sent home with each student. Please support your child's attempts to solicit donations. Encourage them to ask grandparents, aunts and uncles, neighbors (please do not solicit strangers), family friends, parents' co-workers, doctors, dentists, coaches, tutors, and babysitters. Sponsors can donate on a per lap basis or if they prefer a flat, one-time donation. If your student needs an additional pledge sheet, please print one off the website or get a copy up at the office.

Students Trot/Jog

All students will participate the day of the event regardless of whether they have collected donations or not. Students will run with their homeroom at a specified time. The schedule will be posted prior to the event. Students will attempt to walk/jog/trot/run as many laps as possible during a 30 minute period, around a $\frac{1}{4}$ mile course. The typical student will likely complete approximately 8-12 laps during the 30 minutes. Volunteers will help keep track of each student's laps.

Prizes and Recognition

There will be several opportunities for students to earn prizes and be recognized for their efforts. Some prizes will be based on participation (laps completed) and others on donation collected and amount of sponsor who donated. A prize sheet with details is attached.

We want to encourage all students to get out and collect donations. This gives the child a sense of responsibility making it that much more rewarding when they receive their fun prizes.
